Si vous regardez la deuxième page, vous comprendrez l'origine du titre de la suite de *Dracula : The Un-Dead*. La page 1 montre le premier brouillon de Bram Stoker : l'établissement de la liste des personnages. Beaucoup d'entre eux n'apparaissent pas dans la version originale mais sont présents dans *Dracula, l'Immortel*, y compris le fameux inspecteur Cotford.
